However, the West Coast, Texas, and the Atlantic Corridor will see normal to above-normal rainfall.
- July's full Moon, the Full Buck Moon, occurs on Monday, July 21. It reaches
  peak illumination at 6:17 A.M. (EDT), rising above the horizon after sunrise
  —but it will still be spectacular in the night sky.
- July 5 is the time of aphelion when Earth is the farthest it will get from the Sun for the entire year—specifically, we'll be 94,506,364 miles away from our bright star!
- Diana, the Princess of Wales, was adored by many as she changed the way

#### Instructions

- 1. Slice the avocados in half, remove the pit, and scoop into a mixing bowl.
- 2. Mash the avocado with a fork and make it as chunky or smooth as you'd like.
- 3. Add the remaining ingredients and stir together. Give it a taste test and add a pinch more salt or lime juice if needed.
- 4. Serve the guacamole with tortilla chips.

- 3 Avocados, ripe
- 1/2 small yellow onion, finely diced
- 2 roma tomatos, diced
- 3 tablespoons finely chopped fresh
- cilantro
- 1 jalapeno pepper, remove seeds
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 lime, juiced
- 1/2 teaspoon sea salt


